Request: Veterans Services quarterly update: January 2022- March 31, 2022

Linn County Veterans Service Office is here to serve the Local Veterans. We have two accredited veterans service officers that allows us to legally file claims with the Veterans Administration.

These claims include but, are not limited to:

- Service connection Compensation
- Non-service connected pension to include aid and attendance
- Survivor pension and Aid and Attendance (A&A)
- Numerous other benefits

Linn County Veterans Services has served over 8,900 veterans.

The recoveries (this is awards for claims, that have been granted or other benefits that we help with) has been brought into Linn County for this quarter \$ 501,549.10

Recoveries since June 1, 2021 to present \$1,489,016.59

In January 2022 we were awarded a transportation grant of \$11,000 and since then we have used \$727.18. This grant is to be used for Compensation and Pension exams, that the veteran may need to go to for the claims that they have filed with us or have a medical appointment that is VA related.

With this grant we have been able to help veterans get from Sweet Home all the way up to Portland. Quality Medical Transport do require a 72 hours' notice, but are very open to last minute appointments if they have availability. We just ask that Veterans call our office and we make any arrangements.

In September 2021 we applied for a Suicide Awareness Grant through Oregon Department of Veterans Affairs (ODVA) and we were awarded \$4,000. We are working with a local nonprofit group in Lebanon, Lebanon Area Mental Health Alliance, and in September we will be joining them for the suicide walk, in Lebanon, they do this walk every year and we will be providing food and drinks.

With this grant we have purchased gunlocks (\$2,790.00) we had printed the Suicide Hotline and our office information on the other side.

In June we will join this group in the Lebanon Strawberry Festival parade
