WHEREAS, At 10:00 a.m., on July 31, 2018, the Board conducted a first regularly scheduled and duly advertized public meeting and reading and considered the proposed amendments to the Surveyor's Code;

WHEREAS, At 9:35 a.m., on August 14, 2018, the Board conducted a second regularly scheduled and duly advertized public meeting and reading and considered the proposed amendments to the Surveyor's Code;

WHEREAS, This Ordinance changes the mode of selection of the Linn County Surveyor from elected to appointed and must be submitted to and approved by the electors of Linn County before taking effect, pursuant to ORS 203.035(3); and

WHEREAS, The Board having read the proposed ordinance; now, therefore,

The Linn County Board of Commissioners Ordains as Follows:

Section 1. Amendment. LCC Chapter 320 is amended as set forth in Exhibit 1 (redline indicates text that has been added to the Code; ~~strikeout~~ indicates text that has been deleted from the Code).

Section 2. Savings clause. Repeal of a code section or ordinance shall not revive a code section or ordinance in force before or at the time the repealed code section or ordinance took effect.

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1 The repeal shall not affect a punishment or penalty incurred before the repeal took effect, nor a suit,
2 prosecution, or proceeding pending at the time of the repeal for an offense committed under the
3 repealed code section or ordinance.

4 **Section 3. Severability.** Invalidity of a section or part of a section of this ordinance shall not
5 affect the validity of the remaining sections or parts of sections.

6 **Section 4. Effective date.** This ordinance shall take effect on January 1, 2019 if approved by
7 the electors of Linn County at the November 6, 2018 general election.

8 **Section 5. Codification.** Following adoption and approval, this ordinance shall be codified
9 pursuant to LCC Chapter 120.

320.005 Title

This Chapter, LCC 320.005 to LCC 320.300, shall be known and may be cited as the "Linn County Surveyor's Code" or simply as the "Surveyor's Code."

320.050 Election ~~Appointment~~ of County Surveyor

~~Under authority of Oregon Laws 2009, Chapter 491, the~~ **The** position of Linn County Surveyor ~~shall continue as an elective position.~~ **shall be appointed by the Linn County Board of Commissioners. The appointed Surveyor shall serve at the pleasure of the Board.**

320.100 Authority

320.200 Private surveys, mandated surveys, liability

(A) Except as provided in subsection (B) of this section, in addition to performing the duties of county surveyor, the county surveyor may perform a survey of any tract of land in the county at the expense of the person requesting the survey.

(B) A county surveyor shall not perform a survey pursuant to LCC 320.200 (A) that would interfere with the surveyor's duties as county surveyor.

(C) A survey performed pursuant to LCC 320.200 (A) shall not for any purpose, be considered a service rendered in the course or scope of the county surveyor's office or employment. No liability shall attach to, or be assumed by, Linn County from the performance of or agreement to perform, that survey by the surveyor.

320.300 County line surveys

(A) In any survey affecting a county line, the county surveyor shall notify in writing the surveyor of the adjoining county and shall make reasonable efforts to cooperate with that surveyor in making the survey. Notice shall be considered given in accordance with this section if properly addressed and mailed at least six calendar days before commencing the survey.

(B) Upon completion of the survey, the surveyor shall file a copy of the plat and field notes of the survey in the county surveyor's office.

SUMMARY

Currently the Linn County Surveyor is elected by the voters of Linn County to a four year term. Approval of this measure would change the office to a position appointed by the Linn County Board of Commissioners for an indefinite period.

The Linn County Board of Commissioners adopted Ordinance 2018-252 to change the mode of selection of the Linn County Surveyor from election to appointment. Approval of this measure would change the mode of selection of the Office of the Linn County Surveyor from an elective office to an appointed position. Currently the Linn County Surveyor is elected by the voters of Linn County to a four year term. Approval of this measure would change the office to a position appointed by the Linn County Board of Commissioners for an indefinite period. Approval of this measure would not affect the current term of office of the Linn County Surveyor which expires in January 2021.

In 2009 the Oregon Legislature enacted Chapter 491 Oregon Laws 2009 which changed State law to require that the governing body of a county appoint a county surveyor, unless an adopted county charter or a county ordinance provides otherwise. Prior to 2009, Oregon State law required that county surveyors be elected. The Linn County Board of Commissioners, as the governing body for Linn County, adopted Ordinance No. 2009-555 providing that the Linn County Surveyor would continue as an elected position.

In August 2018 the Linn County Board of Commissioners adopted Ordinance 2018-252 to change the mode of selection of the Linn County Surveyor from election to appointment. Under Oregon law, the change of the mode of selection of a County elective office to an appointed position must be submitted to and approved by the voters of Linn County before taking effect.
