

The Juvenile Department received 86 referrals during the month of July 2019.

Of the 86 referrals, 12 represent dependency, 40 status and 34 criminal.

There are currently 272 youth in the Probation Unit either on probation or pending court with 64 of those being assessed high-risk.

There are currently 157 youth under the Community Programs Unit serving on informal probation and the Intervention Specialist is currently serving 75 youth.

Victim Advocate is serving 94 .









Board Summaries for August 27, 2019

R&O 2019-238

This is an Intergovernmental Agreement between Linn County and the Benton County for Mobile Crisis Services. Mobile Crisis will work collaboratively with Law Enforcement and social service agencies by responding directly to the community with community agencies. This amendment renews our funding for \$363,394.44 for the 19-21 biennium year.

R&O 2019-258

This is an Intergovernmental Agreement between Linn County and the Oregon Health Authority for room modifications for Parent Child Interaction Therapy Services (PCIT). This agreement is for one time funding of \$15,000 to modify the Sweet Home office and allow the Health Department to expand services to our Sweet Home office.

R&O 2019-280

This is an Intergovernmental Agreement between Linn County and Pacific University for a Student Affiliation Agreement. This agreement is for an unpaid Mental Health Social worker Internship. Linn County will provide educational experience to students for their practicum-learning experience.

R&O 2019-287

This is an Intergovernmental Agreement between Linn County and the Oregon Health Authority for CHOICE model services. CHOICE model services will allow the mental health department to offer oversight and care coordination for Adults with Severe and Persistent Mental Illness. This agreement renews our funding for \$490,061.54 for the 19-21 biennium year.

Re: BOC Meeting Agenda Summary for R&O 2019-273

- Resolution and Order 2019-273 updates the farming lease we have with Robert Sherfy on the County owned property at Seven Mile Lane to reflect the recent Oregon Military Department (OMD) acquisition of some of the property. The lease is for grass seed farming and sheep grazing. The County will receive \$110.00 per acre for the grass seed farming and 4 cents per head per day for the sheep grazing. We are also working with the OMD to continue a similar farming agreement on the adjacent property, which OMD acquired from Linn County earlier this year.
 - The lease agreement is renewable annually, however when the County decides to develop the property there is language allowing the County to end the lease.
