Update for 2020

Detention

Benton: 10 youth were held for 48 total of days of care, 4 females and 6 males.

Total Admissions to Detention = 10

Average Length of Stay = 4.8 days

Average Daily Population = 1.55 youth

Linn: 28 youth were held for 250 total of days of care, 8 females and 20 males.

Total Admissions to Detention = 31

Average Length of Stay = 8.06 days

Average Daily Population = 8.07 youth

Time for Change Program: 2 (Linn)

Probation

The Juvenile Department received 84 referrals during the month of January 2020.

Of the 84 referrals, 4 represent dependency, 46 status and 34 criminal.

There are currently 249 youth in the Probation Unit either on probation or pending court with 57 of those being assessed high-risk.

There are currently 133 youth under the Community Programs Unit serving on informal probation and the Intervention Specialist is currently serving 107 youth.

Victim Advocate is serving 90 cases.

Work Crew

Tier 1 – 9 youth completed 144.50 hours of community service in 4 project days. In 2019 11 youth completed 137.75 hours of service during the same time period.

Tier 2 – 25 youth completed 458.25 hours of work crew in 20 project days. In 2019 37 youth completed 659.00 hours of service during the same time period.

Miscellaneous Business -

Last update I mentioned our native planting day at the detention facility. In the end we planted nearly 6000 native starts which will be sold and placed into projects being worked on by the City of Albany (Talking Waters, Periwinkle Creek) and Calapooia Watershed, Oceans Blue, Oregon Dept. of Forestry.





January 2020 Statistics







Note: Person, Property & Drug Crimes are at the ALLEGATION level.




