Resolution & Order 2022-018 (Proposed): At the request of the Linn County Real Property Program Manager, the Board set a hearing for Tuesday January 4, 2022 at 10:15 a.m. to hear public objections to the proposed transfer of approximately 2.68 acres of Tax Lot 2204, 13S01E2900, to the City of Sweet Home. This hearing is required in order to transfer the property under ORS 271.330. After hearing and consideration of any objections, if the Board decides to approve transfer of the property this Resolution and Order authorizes such transfer and directs the Real Property Program Manager to work with City of Sweet Home staff to finalize the proposed partition authorized by the Board by Resolution & Order No. 2021-407 and prepare final documents to transfer the property.
