The following items are scheduled to be heard on July 6, 2021 (with a second reading scheduled on July 20, 2021 for 2021-192 and 2021-193):

Ordinance No. 2021-192: *“In the Matter of Amending LCC 650, the Linn County Parking Code”*

- ▶ LCC 650, Linn County Parking Code, requires amendments to clarify procedures and to allow for more effective removal of unlawfully parked vehicles from County property. First reading only.

Ordinance No. 2021-193: *“In the Matter of Amending LCC 630, the Contract Administration Code”*

- ▶ LCC 630, Contract Administration Code, requires amendments to update obsolete language and clarify procedures for adopting Linn County Public Contracting Rules pursuant to the new statute. Gives departments change order authority over \$50,000 in certain circumstances. First reading only.

Ordinance No. 2021-218: *“In the Matter of Amending LCC 610, the Forest-Park System Code and Declaring an Emergency”*

- ▶ LCC 610, Forest-Park System Code, requires amendments to exclude aggressive animals from the forest-park system and to prohibit certain activities within 50 feet of a Boating Water Safety Barrier (boom). Emergency Ordinance; shall take effect upon passage.

Resolution No. 2021-194: *“In the Matter of Amending the Linn County Exclusion Policy”*

- ▶ LCP 39, Linn County Exclusion Policy, requires amendments that will further protect the County, including the inclusion of a witness affidavit requirement, and a clarification that orders are to be stayed while an appeal is pending.

Resolution No. 2021-195: *“In the Matter of Amending the Removal of Unlawful Campsites Located on Public Property Policy”*

- ▶ LCP 43, Removal of Unlawful Campsites Located on Public Property, requires amendments to match the new requirements of recently-passed legislation, specifically 2021's HB 3124.

The following item is scheduled to be signed by the Board on July 6, 2021:

Resolution & Order No. 2021-129 – PD20-0280; a conditional use permit application by Lynn Merrill (Applicant) to establish an alternative forestland dwelling on a 4.38-acre property zoned F/F. The property is located on the south side of Snow Peak Road, approximately 0.43 miles west of the intersection of Snow Peak Road and Green Mountain Drive, and approximately 1.36 miles northeast of the rural community of Lacombe (T11S, R01E, Section 21, Tax Lot 1802).

The Board held public hearings on May 11, 2021 and June 15, 2021 and voted 2-0 to approve the application.
