Re: R & O 2020-141-Edgewater Marina Waterway Barriers (Boom) Purchase,
Linn County Park Update

- **R & O 2020-141-Edgewater Marina Waterway Barriers (Boom) Purchase:** Linn County Parks is requesting approval to purchase a waterway barrier (Tuffboom) system from Worthington Product for \$79,923.60. The Boom is to replace the existing boom that is constantly breaking leaving the Marina un protected. The Worthington Tuffboom is the same boom system the Army Corps of Engineers is using at Foster and Green Peter Dams. We have tried several times to repair the existing boom and none of the repairs we have tried has lasted more than a month. The Parks Staff has determined the best solution is to replace the boom.
- **Parks Update & Parks Commission Camping Recommendation**

The Linn County Parks Commission has passed a motion to supporting the re-opening of Linn County Park's campground facilities as soon as possible. The Parks Commission has recommended that the Parks Staff put together necessary plans to facilitate safely re-opening as many campsites as possible.

RE: Resolution & Order #2020-134 Approval to Obtain Re-Bid for General Services Building Reroof Project

Russ Williams will appear before the Board with Resolution & Order 2020-134 to request the Board's approval of this resolution and order that authorizes General Services to re-obtain bids to reroof the General Services Building. The Board declined all the bids on April 7th as the quotes came in over the allotted budget and due to concerns over the timing of the bids. With a better bidding economy now and some minor adjustments to the scope, General Services will re-bid re-roofing of the General Services roof. The proposed schedule is to award the project in before the end of June and give the bidders a large installation window to schedule the work between the contract award date and October 2020. This is an increase that is within the Surveyor's budget which needs to be increased in order to transfer the money from the Clerk's budget to the Corner Preservation Fund's budget. The revenue came in higher than anticipated and we can't move it without raising the Corner Preservation Fund to accept it.
