RESOLUTION & ORDER 2018-356

This grant for \$38,000 and is for a UAV or drone. The UAV will be used almost exclusively for Search and Rescue missions. We will also use it for major crime scenes where a written search warrant is executed. There are no matching funds with this grant. The grant pays for the UAV and a couple high powered lenses.

RESOLUTION & ORDER 2018-357

This grant is for \$284,513. This is a once in a career type grant for the Sheriff's Office. This is an armored personnel vehicle that can take a 50 caliber round. There are no matching funds for this grant. This will greatly enhance our SWAT teams capacity to resolve issues. This vehicle will allow our operators to get close to a residence while protected inside this vehicle. We can deliver phones and different devices to communicate with barricaded subjects to resolve critical situations.

Our world has changed the last 10 years. A fire truck was attacked last week in Springfield. They took shotgun rounds to the cab while responding to a emergency call. We need to have equipment like this to protect ourselves and the public from that type evil.

Our costs involved with this vehicle involve shipping it (\$14k), training two operators to use it and equipping it with radio/computer equipment for communication.
