R&O 2018-105

This is an Intergovernmental Agreement between George Fox University and Linn County. This is a student affiliation agreement to supervise Mental Health graduate students as part of an unpaid internship.

R&O 2018-293

This is an Intergovernmental Agreement between Lincoln County and Linn County to provide services through the Prescription Drug Overdose Prevention (PDOP) grant to reduce the misuse and abuse of prescription drug medications. Lincoln County is the fiscal agent for this grant which will fund up to \$20,000 to Linn County Alcohol and Drug program as part of a regional grant.

R&O 2018-302

This is an Appointment of Members to the Linn County Mental Health Advisory Board. This will appoint Sarah Helgeson to position eight and Melissa Yates to position nine with both appointments ending 12/31/2020.

Refund Request

This is a refund request from Environmental Health to a private citizen for \$1,300. The applicant applied for three site evaluations. During the first one evaluation, the conditions were found to be horrible so they elected to stop the remaining evaluations. They have cancelled the project and are requesting a refund for the two unfinished of the site evaluations.

RE: Background Information for Agenda Items – 9/4/2018

The Road Department has the following items on the Board of Commissioners agenda for the weekly meeting on September 4, 2018. The following is a brief description of the items.

Resolution & Order 2018-276 – Road Closure for a “Best in the West Triathlon Festival”

This item is a request by Blair Bronson of Best in the West Events, to close certain portions of North River Drive and Quartzville Road. A Board Order is required for any closure of a road under Linn County jurisdiction if the reason for the closure is not road maintenance or utility construction activities. The Road Department works cooperatively with the Applicant to ensure that the closure is accomplished in a safe and efficient manner.

Resolution & Order 2018-277 – Delegation of Authority to Purchase a Fuel Island Canopy for the Sweet Home Fuel Facility

This authorizes the Roadmaster to execute a purchase order to purchase a fuel island canopy for the Sweet Home Fuel Facility at a cost in excess of \$50,000. The total quote for the canopy is \$118,994.25.

Resolution & Order 2018-286 – Traffic Control Regulation on Jefferson-Scio Drive, County Road 0004

This resolution and order designates a permanent “no parking” regulation on Jefferson-Scio Drive, County Road No. 0004. The location for the no parking is both sides of the road from Mile Post 0.00 to Mile Post 0.27.

Resolution & Order 2018-291 – Right-of Way Deed Acceptance, North McCully Mountain Road

This is an order to accept a permanent easement for road right-of-way needed on North McCully Mountain Road for repair to a road slide. This project is anticipated to be constructed during the fall of 2018.

Resolution & Order 2018-295 – Bid Advertisement, Foster Dam Road Public Access Improvement Project

This resolution and order authorizes the bid advertisement and sets the bid opening time and date for the Foster Dam Road Public Access Improvement Project.
