SEIU Represented Full Time (37.5 hours/week) position

The **Supported Employment Specialist (SES)** works with individuals with serious and severe mental illness and currently served as clients with Linn County Mental Health Services. The SES serves clients from a maximum of two treatment teams. SES provides individualized support toward placement in competitive employment as well as vocational and educational-goal oriented training. This position will partner directly with local employers to develop customized employment opportunities and support client in a variety of competitive work settings. SES works collaboratively within a clinical team as well as a team of community partners. Primary work site will be Albany, Oregon.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Bachelor's degree (primary studies in a behavioral sciences field); or four years of progressive experience in a mental health program serving clients with severe mental illness; or any satisfactory combination of work experience of serving people with severe mental illness, physical disabilities or intellectual developmental disabilities in a vocational rehabilitation setting.
- Knowledge of basic English composition and reasonable level of computer, Internet and office equipment operation sufficient to instruct clients in their basic operation and use
- Valid Oregon Driver's license
- Must be able to pass a criminal background check
- Preferred experience working with individuals with severe mental illness including supported employment, skill training and case management
- Has an understanding of the Evidence Based Practice of Supported Employment and Individualized Placement and Support (IPS) Model (<https://ipsworks.org/>)
- Electronic Medical Record experience; good time management, adaptability, and strong written and verbal communication skills
