ALCOHOL AND DRUG YOUTH & PREVENTION SERVICES SUPERVISOR
Supervising Mental Health Specialist (LCDHS Classification 774)
Management Full Time (37.5 hours/week) position

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

Provide outpatient substance abuse and mental health treatment, primarily to youth and families, early intervention, and behavioral health promotion and prevention services; and provide clinical and administrative supervision to a team of professional staff providing those services. Duties include client assessments; individual, group, and family therapy; case management; community education, classroom instruction, community organization and consultation; and program development. Supervisory duties include assigning staff responsibilities; providing consultation and direction on problems and interpretation of policies and standards; participation in staff recruitment, training, and performance evaluation. Provide leadership and advanced skills in developing and implementing prevention, early intervention, and treatment services, which are responsive to community needs. Work closely with program teams providing substance abuse and problem gambling services to adults, and with Department of Health Services programs providing public health, mental health, and developmental disabilities services. Develop funding proposals, track outcome measures, and complete timely reports. Occasional evening work and travel to outlying areas in the county is required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Advanced professional-level knowledge and skills in behavioral health promotion and prevention for youth and adults, and in the treatment of substance use and mental disorders in youth and adults. Ability to develop collaborative working relationships and to exercise sound judgment in providing consultation and leadership within the community. Ability to make presentations, compile evaluation data, and write reports. Ability to learn and monitor program adherence to Oregon Revised Statutes, Oregon Administrative Rules, and county and department policies and procedures. Ability to provide clinical and administrative supervision to professional and paraprofessional staff.

Master's Degree in psychology, social work, counseling or related field is required. Six years of post-Master's Degree professional experience of a progressively responsible nature and in a similar capacity is required. Any satisfactory equivalent combination of experience, education and training which demonstrates the ability to perform the work may be acceptable. Requires Oregon licensure as a Licensed Professional Counselor, Licensed Clinical Social Worker, or Licensed Marriage & Family Therapist, or certification as a Certified Alcohol & Drug Counselor-Level II (CADC II) by the Addiction Counselor Certification Board of Oregon. Ability to pass a criminal history check, possession of a valid Oregon motor vehicle operator's license and acceptable driving record are required.
