GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES/JOB OBJECTIVES: Operates and performs routine maintenance on light or medium duty equipment used in road construction or maintenance involving skilled or difficult operations; assists in performance of skilled manual tasks. Must be able to perform duties of lower Maintenance Worker classification.

SUPERVISION RECEIVED: Works under the direction of a Division Supervisor, Leadworker, or maintenance worker of higher grade who assigns work, observes performance and instructs in proper method.

SUPERVISION EXERCISED: Supervision is not normally a responsibility of this class, but duties may involve occasionally exercising working supervision over a few maintenance personnel.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS: A person employed in this classification must possess the capability to perform the following duties to be considered for this position. The duties are essential functions requiring the critical skills and expertise needed to meet job objectives. Additional specific details of these essential functions may be provided by the specific office or department job announcement, if applicable.

- 1.* Truck Driver - Operates a single axle truck in hauling and dumping construction materials.
- 2.* Loader Operator - Operates front end loader up to and including 2-1/2 cubic yard capacity for moving earth and rocks, filling trucks, or other operations.
- 3.* Roller Operator - Operates self-propelled roller for finishing newly paved or patched highways, compacting rock shoulders, and other operations.
- 4.* Power Mower/Broom Operator - Operates mower/broom on right-of-way to cut grade on highway shoulder and roadsides; trims vegetation along fences, back slopes, sweep road surface, etc.
5. Kettle Operator - Operates kettle in heating asphalt, maintaining proper temperature, pressure boil and circulation in kettle; does penetration and other types of oil or bituminous patching requiring specific techniques; moves kettle by truck to new locations.

OTHER FUNCTIONS:

6. Other duties as assigned.

RECRUITING REQUIREMENTS: (Additional specific details may be provided by the specific office or department job announcement, if applicable).

KNOWLEDGE, SKILL AND ABILITY: Knowledge of the operation, maintenance and minor repair of motor equipment; considerable knowledge of the methods and materials used; ability to operate equipment safely under adverse conditions; skill in the performance of specialized manual work; good physical condition to permit work out of doors in adverse weather.

EXPERIENCE, EDUCATION AND TRAINING: Graduation from a senior high school or GED and one year experience in the operation of road maintenance equipment such as maintenance trucks, mowing machines, rollers, etc. Experience in performing semi-skilled manual tasks or a satisfactory equivalent combination of experience, education and training, which demonstrate the ability to perform the work described.

NECESSARY SPECIAL QUALIFICATIONS: Possession of a Commercial Drivers License Class "A" with Air Brake and Tanker endorsement and an acceptable driving record.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS AND WORK ENVIRONMENTAL: Work is performed indoors and outdoors in all types of weather and in all areas of the county. Work requirements include the ability to see, talk, hear, sit, stand, walk, bend, stoop, kneel, jump and run. The ability to use hands to finger, handle or operate objects, tools or controls, to reach with hands and arms and to lift or move ninety (90) pounds is also required.
