#### **30.010 Presumptions that directives are issued by the Board**

(A) A directive issued by one Board member is presumed to have been given by the Board unless there is clear, reasonable evidence to the contrary.

(B) It shall be the policy of the Linn County Board of Commissioners that when giving directive to any County department head, that the authority of the direction represents the position of at least two of the three members of the Board of Commissioners.

#### **30.020 Department head responsibility**

(A) It shall be the policy of the Linn County Board of Commissioners that when directive to

any County department head, that the authority of the direction represents the position of at least two of the three members of the Board of Commissioners.

(B) Whenever a department head is unsure whether or not a directive has the concurrence of at least two Commissioners, the department head shall take the initiative to ask the other Commissioners members of the Board whether or not they concur with the directive.

(C) In cases where a directive is given to a department head and the department head has reason to feel comfortable that the request represents the thinking of two members of the Board of Commissioners, the department head may proceed to carry out the directive.

(D) If, at any time, the department head in the process of carrying out such a directive feels that he is unsure that his original perception was correct, the department head shall take the initiative to inquire of the other Commissioners regarding their feelings about the directive.
