Summary 175 words which concisely and impartially summarizes the measure and its major effect. <p>Measure replaces current law enforcement levy (expiring June 2022), and continues operational and capital funding for law enforcement services for an additional four years. This levy maintains, and enhances, existing public safety services, with revenues funding operations of the Sheriff's Office (76%), criminal prosecution (10%), plus juvenile offender supervision and detention (14%).</p> <p>Maintain:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Patrol and investigations, 24-hours per day, and prosecution of property and person crimes, especially homicides; • Victims' assistance for all crime victims; • Juvenile programs reducing crime; • Operation of 230-bed Jail facility, reducing the number of prisoners released early. <p>Added:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Renovate and upgrade female housing in Jail, and 9-1-1 Communications Center; • Improve digital forensic services and technology; • Increase mental health crisis response, in partnership with mental health professionals, helping people in crisis connect with medical assistance; • Enhance and promote Emergency Preparedness initiatives for wildfires, flooding and severe weather. <p>In 2021, typical homeowners with an assessed value (not market value) of \$185,000 would pay \$551.30 annually, an increase of \$27.75 per year from the current rate.</p> <p>This four year levy would produce, at a tax rate of \$2.98 per \$1,000 assessed value, an estimated total of \$147,463,473.00 from the following estimated annual authorizations to levy: \$35,379,523.00 in 2022; \$36,352,460.00 in 2023; \$37,352,153.00 in 2024; and \$38,379,337.00 in 2025.</p> <p>A "YES" VOTE APPROVES LINN COUNTY'S LAW ENFORCEMENT LEVY.</p> <p>The estimated tax cost for this measure is an ESTIMATE ONLY based on the best information available from the county assessor at the time of estimate and may reflect the impact of early payment discounts, compression and the collection rate.</p>
