Executed August 14, 2018 in the County of Linn in the Oregon State.

Be it known to all presents that the Second Amendment Preservation Ordinance (SAPO) Committee does hereby file the following as the "Explanatory Statement" required by "Linn County — State Voters' Pamphlet Code" 250.350 (A)(4):



A YES vote adopts and makes the Second Amendment Preservation Ordinance part of Linn County's County Code. If approved the ordinance does the following:  
 Entrusts the Linn County Sheriff to determine, on behalf of Linn County, whether certain firearms laws are Constitutional.  
 If the Linn County Sheriff determines that any federal, state or local laws affecting firearms, firearms accessories or ammunition are Unconstitutional then the County may not authorize the use of funds, resources, employees, agencies, contractors, buildings, detention centers, or offices for the purpose of enforcing such laws.  
 Approval of this measure would subject people or corporations who violate this measure by enforcing firearms laws declared by the sheriff to be unconstitutional to a fine of up to \$2,000 for an individual and \$4,000 for a corporation.
