

Shall the mode of selection of the Linn County Surveyor be changed from election by voters to appointment by Commissioners?

Summary 175 words which concisely and impartially summarizes the measure and its major effect.

Approval of this measure would change the mode of selection of the Office of the Linn County Surveyor from an elective office to an appointed position. Currently the Linn County Surveyor is elected by the voters of Linn County to a four year term. Approval of this measure would change the office to a position appointed by the Linn County Board of Commissioners for an indefinite period.

The Linn County Board of Commissioners adopted Ordinance 2018-252 to change the mode of selection of the Linn County Surveyor from election to appointment. Under Oregon law, the change of the mode of selection of an elective county office to an appointed position must be submitted to and approved by the voters of Linn County before taking effect.

A Yes vote would change the mode of selection of the Linn County Surveyor from election to appointment by the Linn County Board of Commissioners.

A No vote would retain the current mode of selection of the Linn County Surveyor of election by the voters.
