LIFE CHOICES CLASS

This two night class is designed to educate youth on making better choices for a successful life. A parent/guardian must attend this two night class with the youth. It is instructed by a police officer and a staff member from Neighbor to Neighbor Mediation Services. The first night starts with educating the youth on what are the most common misdemeanor crimes, and ends with common thinking errors and restorative justice. Restorative justice is the act of making the victim whole or repairing the harm or damage done. The second night follows up on restorative justice and ends with what can happen to those who continue to make poor choices. Youth are asked to bring a written question for a police officer to the first class to be used for an ice breaker activity.
